- Web Camera - Min 640 x 480 15fps
- Microphone - Any suitable
- Screen resolution - 1024 x 768 and above
- Network Bandwidth - Min 256 KBPs

# BROWSER PRE-REQUISITIES

- Clear Browser cache 
- Ad blocker should be turned off 
- Popup blocker should be turned off
- Examination will run only on webcam and microphone enabled Desktop or Laptop or Tablet or Smart-Phone  

# INDENIFICATION PROCESS

- **FACE CAPTURING:** During the examination, the AI tool constantly monitors the picture of the student taking the examination with the facial photo captured initially for any mismatch. In case of any mismatch, the system will capture the anomaly and a notification to the student / live proctor is also instantly displayed



- Student must display College ID / Government authorized ID proof at the beginning of the examination

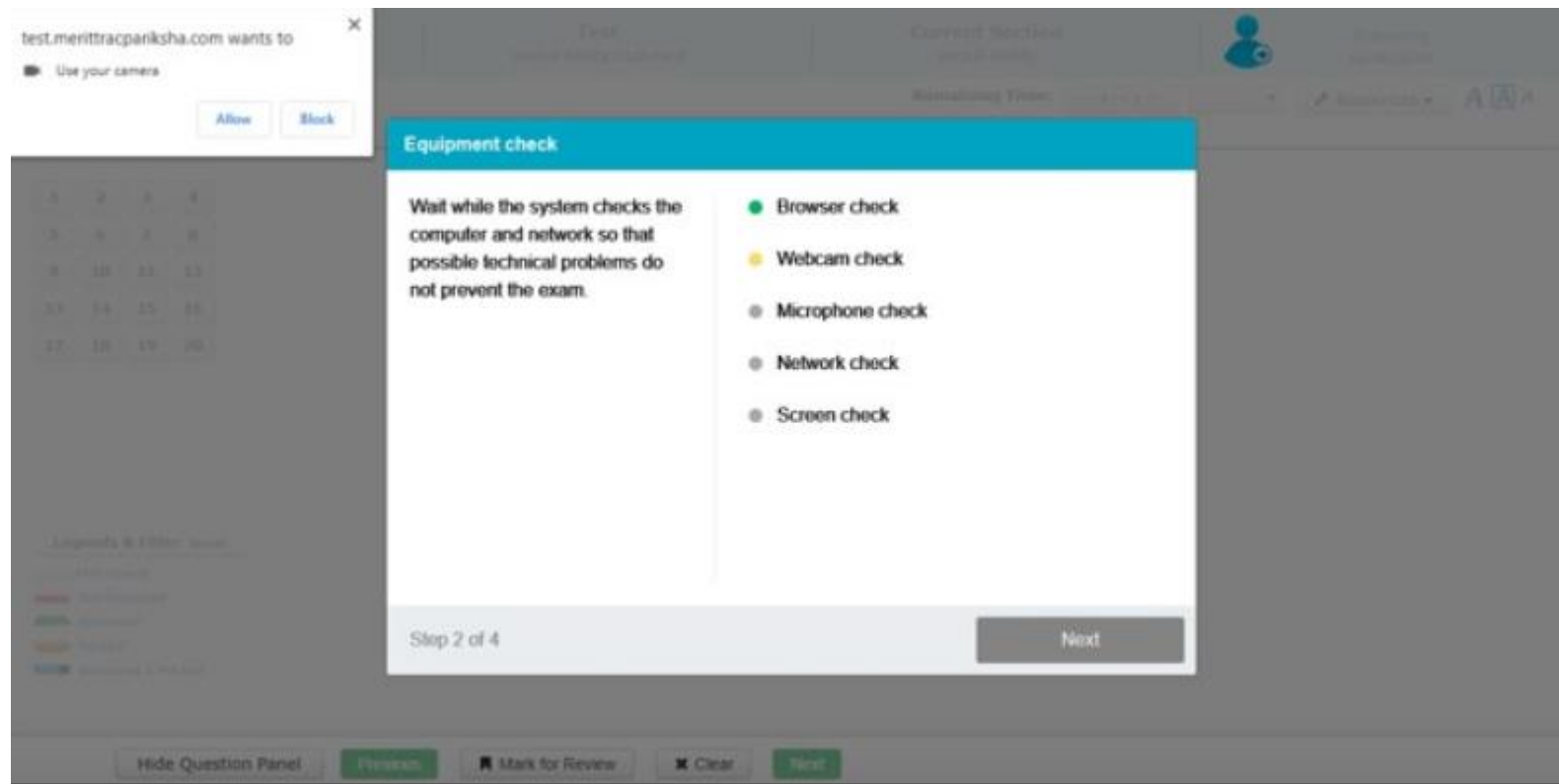

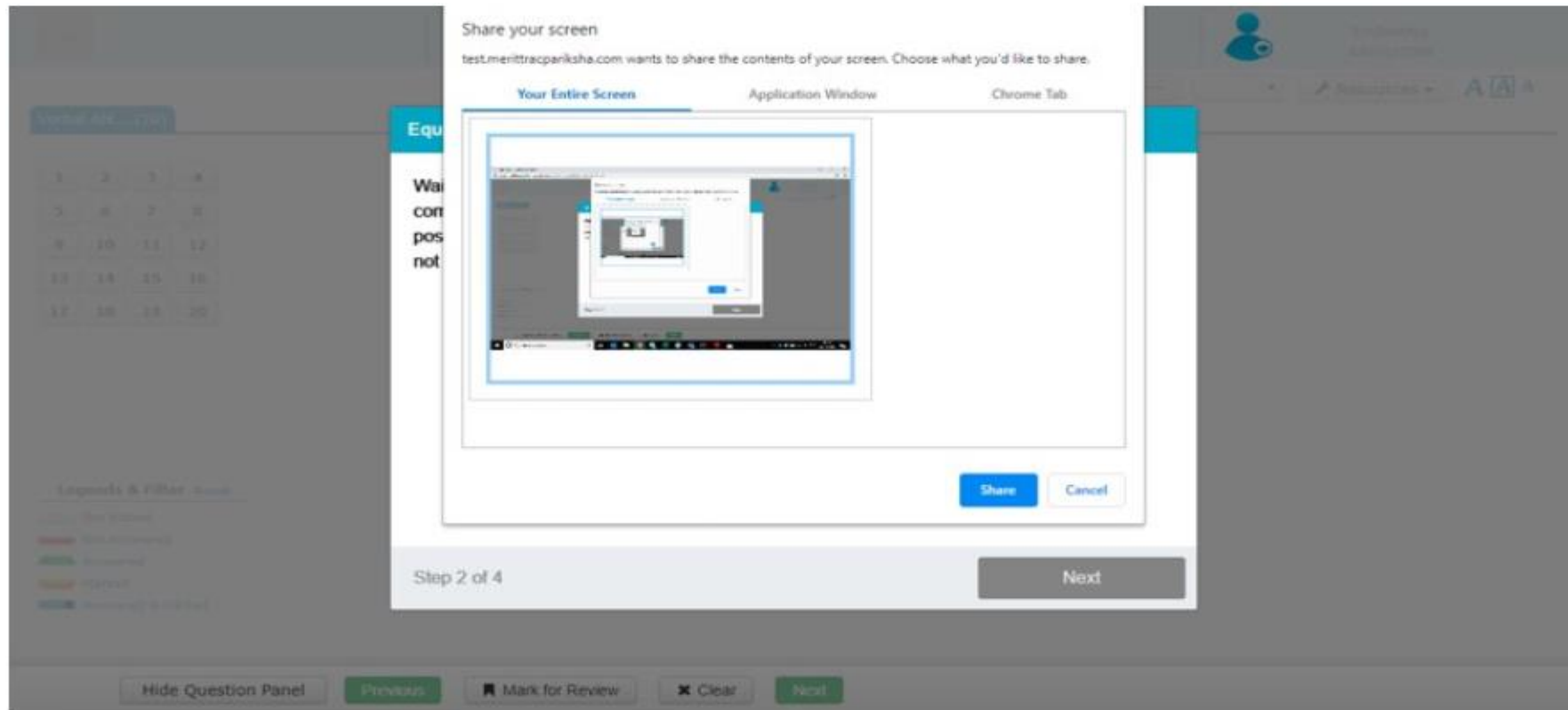

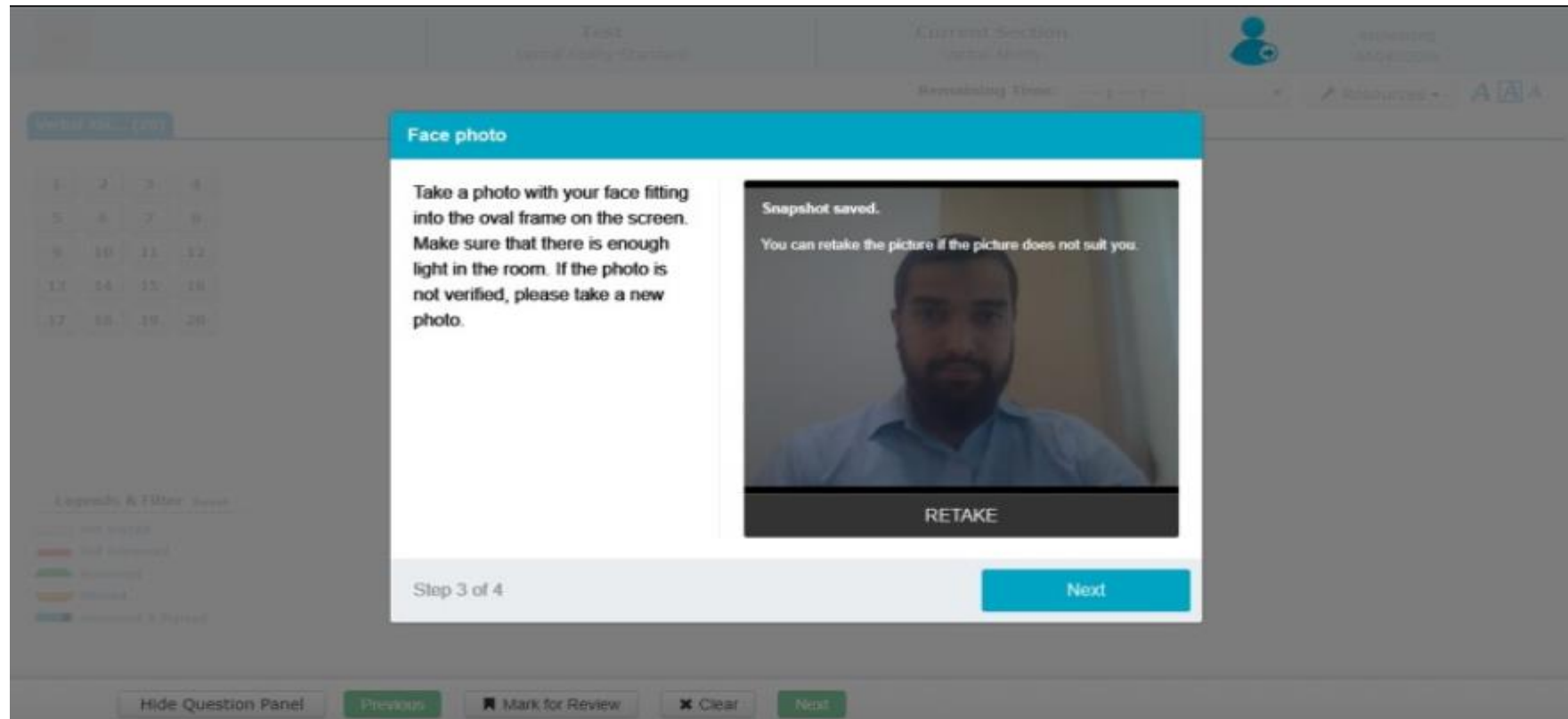

- Students must have the identity proof .
- Use the **SCIENTIFIC CALCULATOR** available onscreen by clicking the **“RESOURCES”** button.
- Ensure that while taking test no one else in that room.



- Do **NOT TRY TO NAVIGATE FROM THE MAIN SCREEN.** Doing so will automatically terminate your examination.
- You are advised **NOT TO USE THE KEYBOARD** while you are attempting the examination; you are only allowed to scroll the cursor with the mouse to answer the question.
- You are not allowed to start the examination from **MULTIPLE DEVICES** at a time.
- Do not use headphones





# CREDIBILITY

- While taking exam we are assigned with the credibility percentage with 100 . If we do anything unfair to the exam means that credibility get decreases. If it falls to certain percentage you will be marked as **MALPRACTICE** automatically by AI.
- So while taking examination ensure that the noise is reduced in place as much possible. Note that due to that noise also credibility gets decreases.
